Concept: Develop understanding of local history e.g. historical events, people and places.

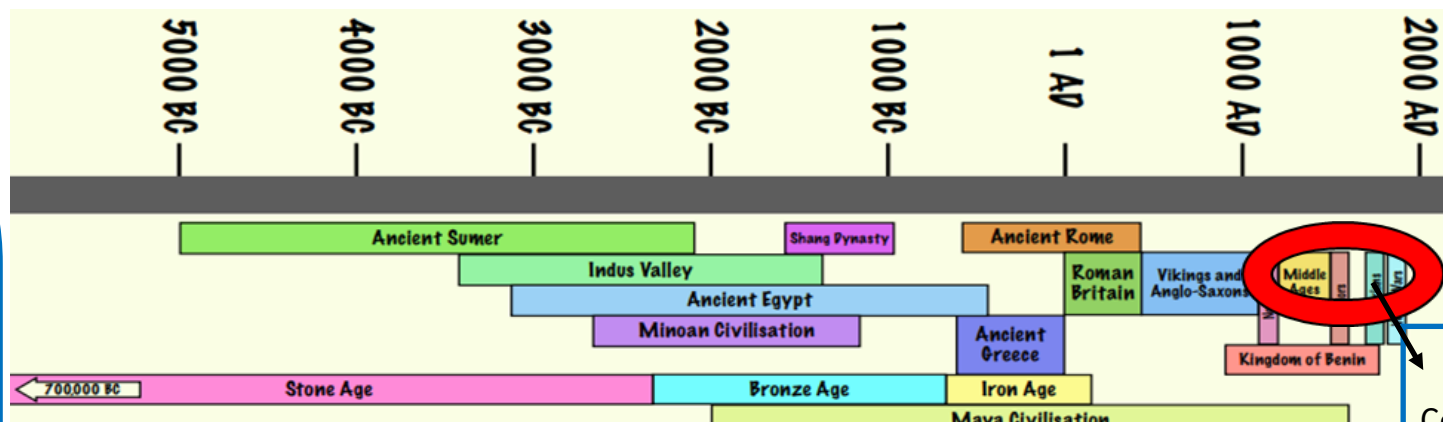
Vocabulary

Local—a place near to us

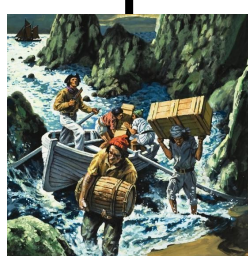
Smuggler— sneaks things into and out of a place.

contraband— items that are not allowed.

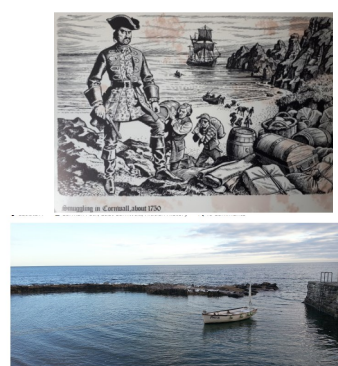


1300 -1500
