- Sharp claws



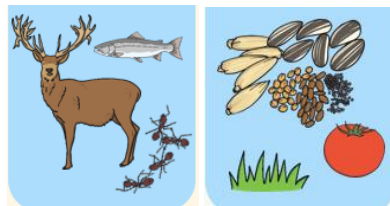
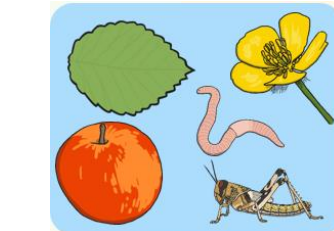
Features of
