habitat: the natural place where something lives

survive: to stay alive

depend: needing each other to survive


adapt: how animals or plants change to fit their environment



Animals need water, food, shelter and air to survive.



Plants need water, light and the correct temperature to survive.



Trees are **living** things. Dogs, cats, fish, snakes, bees and people are also **living** things.

Dry leaves on the ground are **dead**, but they were **once** part of a **living** tree.

Bones were **once** part of a **living** animal that now is **dead**.


Anything metal, plastic or stone has never been alive.
