## Evolution – Understand reproduction and how living things have adapted over time

### Vocabulary

**habitat:** the natural place where something lives

**survive:** to stay alive

**depend:** needing each other to survive

**adapt:** how animals or plants change to fit their environment



Animals need water, food, shelter and air to survive.



Plants need water, light and the correct temperature to survive.

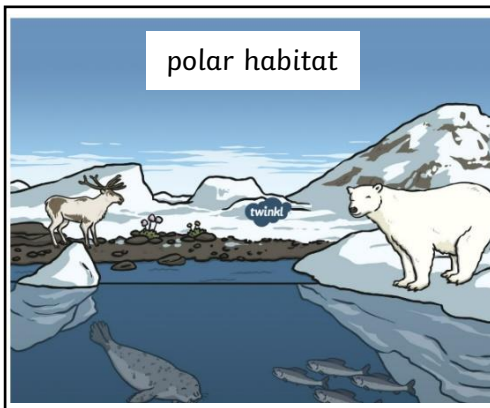
Alive	Once Alive	Never Alive

Trees are **living** things. Dogs, cats, fish, snakes, bees and people are also **living** things.

Dry leaves on the ground are **dead**, but they were **once** part of a **living** tree. Bones were **once** part of a **living** animal that now is **dead**.

Anything metal, plastic or stone has **never been alive**.
