



## Topic web—Where would we be without bees?

As **mathematicians**, we will be learning about fractions, and how to use them. We will learn about length, height and perimeter and then move on to learn about mass, capacity and temperature.

As **historians**, we are going to learn about the effect Ancient Greece has had on our lives today, focusing on the Olympics and mythology.

As learners of different **faiths**, we will explore the question: 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' We'll learn about how people can make the world a good-place.

As **readers** we will be reading the story 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl and **writers**, we will be exploring the story 'The Disgusting Sandwich' by Gareth Edwards. We will use this to create a narrative, then we will create some poetry in a poetry unit.

As **scientists**, we will all be learning about plants. We will be learning about what plants need to grow and the parts of plants. We will complete investigations into the best conditions for growing plants and how water travels through plants.

In **PSHE**, we will focus on bodies and how we take care of them. We will look at eating, sleeping and keeping ourselves safe and healthy.

As **dancers**, we are going to create moves to represent a different animal each week. We will also be learning how to play Boccia.

As **designers**, in DT we are going to be designing and making vehicles. When complete we will evaluate our vehicles.

As **musicians**, we will learn the Dragon Song which has themes of friendship, kindness and taking care of others.

As **computing experts** we will be collecting data, using branching databases and creating charts/presentations.
